






ABOUT THE PROJECT





In Cambodia, students who don't speak English cannot progress through to higher education or enjoy higher paying jobs. Despite this, government schools teach very little English and many teachers charge a high price for extra hours of learning. Most families cannot afford these prices and therefore the child's education suffers. Since 2005, the AKD School has been providing free English classes to Cambodian children of all ages, so that they can look forward to a brighter future.

GBGA team traveled to Bospo village in Battambang, Cambodia to visit AKD school and the project site we hired locals to work on months in advance. Our volunteers finished the final touches by painting the walls and assembling a new playground for the kids. Empowering the school to self-fund itself in the future, we donated bicycles for the students to run city cycle tours and bring in extra income. Thanks to our donors, we also donated sport equipment and classroom and office supplies to upgrade their capability in giving well-rounded education. We hope this project would give the kids the opportunity to further on their studies and motivation to develop their community from within.
