

ABOUT THE PROJECT





Shiksha Bharti School, (SBS), was established by two retired officers, both interested in the field of education. They decided to augment the Government's efforts under the Right to Education Act and help in educating poor and under privileged children who have no access to even primary education. All the beneficiaries of SBS are children of BPL (below poverty line) families and the unorganized migrant labour in Gurgaon. Education provided is free of charge. Word spread and SBS now boasts 250 children on the rolls with over 100 on the waiting list.

To help them get up to the speed with government schools and the national education standard, our GBGA team implemented 2 smart boards enhancing their learning environment with technology. We refurbished and painted the wall to brighten up the outer appearance. Previously muddy and dusty, we laid a new floor in front of the buildingfor the kids to run around on a safer platform, particularly in the wet season.

This project could not be completed without the help of our collaborative partner community and all amazing kids who took parts from start to finish. It was a great quality time getting our hands dirty and building up the education they deserve . We hope our presence also contributes in motivating the students to work hard and give back to their own community in the future as well.
