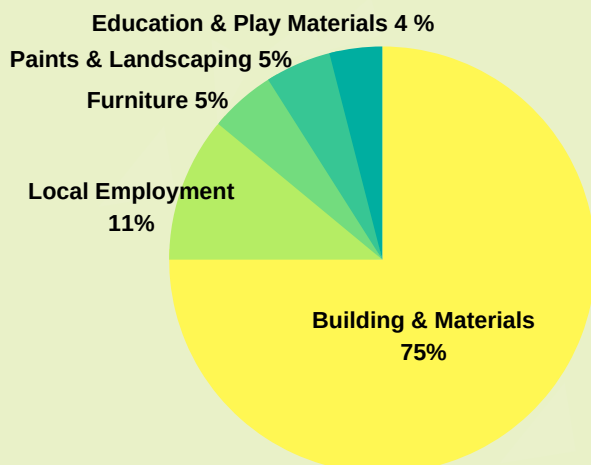

# ABOUT THE PROJECT



The Myanmar project is something truly special. We worked with an amazing local community about 70 minutes outside of Yangon. Located on an island, this community has been struggling ever since Hurricane Nargis in 2015 wiped out most of what they knew. The United Nations moved in directly in the aftermath to save lives but since then the people still lacked of good access to housing and proper education.

The temporary UN building has been used as a high school for the 1,200 strong community but the kindergarten and nursery had nothing but a shack to work with. Step in the GiveBack GiveAway team! We fund-raised our standard \$10,000+ USD, partly through crowd-funding and partly from the project donation. With this, our team of volunteers got our hands on, with the local Burmese locals, building a new school with purpose-made classroom for the students. Also to help facilitate their classroom settings, we also donated TVs and school supplies for a more effective and fun learning environment. The Hmawbi community now has a place for the young generation to grow and get full access to education they deserve.
