

Since Myanmar underwent its first democratic elections, the ethnic tribes on the Thai side of the border have felt the repercussions dramatically. The vast majority of charities, projects and NGO's instantly entered Myanmar, leaving the Burmese migrants in Mae Sot and its surroundings instantly neglected and underfunded. This has left many schools searching for the wherewithal they need to provide equipment for their students. We leaped in to make it all possible for the kids to access the best education they deserve.

With a team of 17 volunteers from 10 different nations, the GiveBack GiveAway provided the students with essentials they need to learn in the classroom as well as building a playground for the kids of the school and community to benefit from.
